Calgary, Alberta - Unitech Energy Resources Inc. The drilling of this well is part of Unitech's obligations under its sub-farmout agreement with Batoche Resources Ltd. to drill, complete and equip (to a single well battery stage) a 2,500 foot horizontal lateral in the Eagle Ford formation with multistage completion on the Lands.
